The State Board of Landscape Architects does not anticipate any significant increase or decrease in expenditures. The added authority to allow the Board to charge an additional fee to cover administrative costs related to applications will allow the Board to pass that cost onto the license or applicant if it so chooses. Currently, the Board is paying those costs. It does not anticipate any significant change in the expense.

The Board does anticipate an increase in license application revenue due to revised requirements. While estimating the number that will take advantage of the revised requirements is difficult, the Board is projecting approximately three additional applications in FY 2025-26 and the same for FY 2026-27.
